

2. For withdrawals before the end of the first week of class – 100%, minus \$75 registration fee.
3. For withdrawals before the end of the second week of class – 50% minus \$75 registration fee.
4. No refund for withdrawals after the end of the second week of class; there is no refund for students who are dismissed for failure to meet standards of discipline or attendance.

Requirements:

If a student must be absent due to illness or other unavoidable reason, the parent must inform the school as soon as possible before the first class that will be missed. Students are expected to be on time for all classes. A student with more than two unexcused absences or excessive tardiness will be dismissed from the course with no refund.

Students in LCCS courses must abide by all disciplinary requirements of the school, including the dress code, and must meet the expectations of the teacher for classroom behavior. Students who violate disciplinary expectations are subject to dismissal with no refund.

Students in LCCS courses must meet the academic requirements of the course, as defined and enforced by the teacher, to receive credit for the course. A student who fails to receive credit due to academic deficiencies will not be entitled to a refund.

Students may be in the high school building no more than 15 minutes before their first class and no later than 15 minutes after their last class. LCCS does not take responsibility for students outside the high school building.

Students who are not enrolled in Lumen Christi Catholic School may not take more than two high school classes in a semester.

LCCS does not guarantee that classes will be open to non-enrolled students in future years.

Relation to High School:

Non-enrolled students meet the same requirements and receive the same attention as enrolled students in the classes they attend. Lumen Christi will provide certificates for classes completed by non-enrolled students.

Unless a student is enrolled in Lumen Christi Catholic School through senior year, he or she cannot receive a LCCS diploma.

Students in grades 9-11 who take high school classes at LCCS may apply for enrollment in LCCS high school beginning in the following semester; one-half of the tuition paid in the previous semester will be applied to tuition for the first semester of enrollment.

Students who take courses at LCCS may be eligible to participate in some extracurricular activities, such as the volleyball team and service projects. They will not be eligible to participate in the March for Life or Pilgrimage trips.
