Here is a code to help you understand the symbols below:

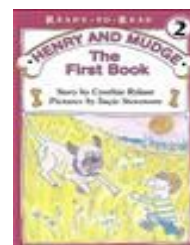
BL means Book Level. Try to choose books that really match your reading level. Consider the level you were reading at the end of the school year. Read at a level that you feel is right for YOU. **AR Points** mean how many points you will earn if you get 100% on the AR quiz after reading the book. You can review the books right before school starts to take the AR tests.

Suggested Books: Students should make a goal of reading at least two chapter books and 5-8 storybooks during the summer. Reading everyday is like taking vitamins! Reading with your parents or listening to audiobooks is acceptable. Enjoy!

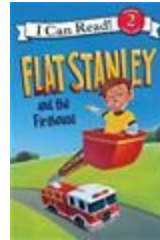

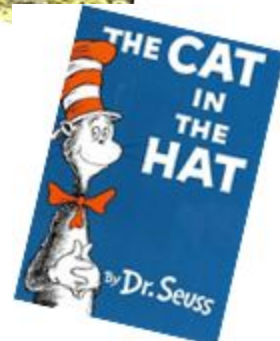
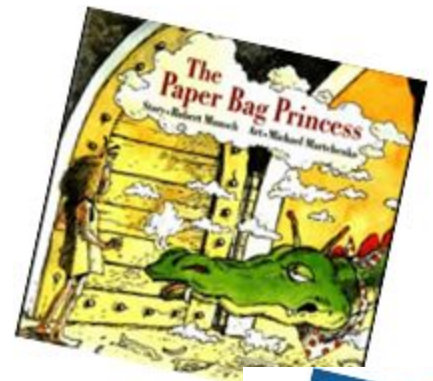
