**LK 18:1-8**

Jesus told his disciples a parable about the necessity for them to pray always without becoming weary. He said,  
"There was a judge in a certain town who neither feared God nor respected any human being. And a widow in that town used to come to him and say, 'Render a just decision for me against my adversary.'

For a long time the judge was unwilling, but eventually he thought,  
'While it is true that I neither fear God nor respect any human being, because this widow keeps bothering me I shall deliver a just decision for her lest she finally come and strike me.'"  
The Lord said, "Pay attention to what the dishonest judge says. Will not God then secure the rights of his chosen ones who call out to him day and night? Will he be slow to answer them? I tell you, he will see to it that justice is done for them speedily. But when the Son of Man comes, will he find faith on earth?"

**LC 18:1-8**

En aquel tiempo, para enseñar a sus discípulos la necesidad de orar siempre y sin desfallecer, Jesús les propuso esta parábola:

"En cierta ciudad había un juez que no temía a Dios ni respetaba a los hombres. Vivía en aquella misma ciudad una viuda que acudía a él con frecuencia para decirle: 'Hazme justicia contra mi adversario'.

Por mucho tiempo, el juez no le hizo caso, pero después se dijo: 'Aunque no temo a Dios ni respeto a los hombres, sin embargo, por la insistencia de esta viuda, voy a hacerle justicia para que no me siga molestando' ".  
Dicho esto, Jesús comentó: "Si así pensaba el juez injusto, ¿creen acaso que Dios no hará justicia a sus elegidos, que claman a él día y noche, y que los hará esperar? Yo les digo que les hará justicia sin tardar. Pero, cuando venga el Hijo del hombre, ¿creen ustedes que encontrará fe sobre la tierra?"

**Pastor's Corner**  
**Fr. M. Uhlenkott**

This is the ninth of a series of sections that I am reprinting from the article, *All Roads Lead to Rome: 10 Reasons to Become [or remain] Catholic* by Sam Guzman from *CatholicGentleman.net*. First, in the words of G.K. Chesterton: “The difficulty of explaining ‘why I am a Catholic’ is that there are ten thousand reasons all amounting to one reason: that Catholicism is true.”

9 . The Catholic Faith is Truly Universal  
The human mind is prone to separate and categorize things into dualities: East and West, European or Asian, Mystical or Rational, Contemplation or Action, Predestination or Freewill, Simple or Complex, Science or Faith, Faith or Works, and on and on. And it's true—many different sects, denominations, and movements represent shards or fragments of the truth, representing one or the other of these dichotomies. But only one institution on earth is large enough and universal enough to embody all of these dichotomies and hold them in perfect tension: the Catholic Church. The Catholic Church has within her 20 some rites both Eastern liturgies and Western liturgies. Among Catholic religious orders, many are active, serving and working, while just as many are contemplative, praying and interceding for the world. The Catholic Church has among her children Africans, and Asians, and Europeans, and Americans, and Hispanics, and every ethnicity under the sun. She teaches the necessity of faith, but also human effort. She teaches the goodness of science but also the necessity of faith. The Catholic Church is universal in every way. She represents the perfect balance of diversity in unity, and within her are contained all the colors and shades of human expression and thought and mysticism held in perfect balance.

9) La fe católica es verdaderamente universal  
La mente humana es propensa a separar y clasificar las cosas en dualidades: este y oeste, europeo o asiático, místico o racional, contemplación o acción, predestinación o libre albedrío, simple o complejo, ciencia o fe, fe u obras, y así sucesivamente. Y es cierto: muchas sectas, denominaciones y movimientos diferentes representan fragmentos o fragmentos de la verdad, que representan una u otra de estas dicotomías. Pero solo una institución en la tierra es lo suficientemente grande y universal para encarnar todas estas dicotomías y mantenerlas en perfecta tensión: la Iglesia Católica.  
La Iglesia Católica tiene dentro de ella 20 y algo ritos tanto liturgias orientales como liturgias occidentales. Entre las órdenes religiosas católicas, muchas son activas, sirven y trabajan, mientras que otras son contemplativas, oran e interceden por el mundo. La Iglesia Católica tiene entre sus hijos africanos, asiáticos, europeos, estadounidenses e hispanos, y todas las etnias bajo el sol. Ella enseña la necesidad de la fe, pero también el esfuerzo humano. Ella enseña la bondad de la ciencia pero también la necesidad de la fe.  
La Iglesia Católica es universal en todos los sentidos. Ella representa el equilibrio perfecto de la diversidad en la unidad, y dentro de ella están contenidos todos los colores y sombras de la expresión humana, el pensamiento y el misticismo en perfecto equilibrio.
