**LK 20:27,34-38**

Some Sadducees, those who deny that there is a resurrection, came forward.

Jesus said to them, "The children of this age marry and remarry; but those who are deemed worthy to attain to the coming age and to the resurrection of the dead neither marry nor are given in marriage. They can no longer die, for they are like angels; and they are the children of God because they are the ones who will rise.

That the dead will rise even Moses made known in the passage about the bush, when he called out 'Lord, ' the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob; and he is not God of the dead, but of the living, for to him all are alive."

**Pastor's Corner**  
**Fr. M. Uhlenkott**

In case you did not have enough reasons to be Catholic, I want to present to you another long list of (50) short reasons for being Catholic that I hope is of interest to you. Again, with these I will also print over the next series of weeks. This list comes to us from catholic-link.org: The world will attempt to give you infinite reasons to not to be Catholic, but in reality, there are *infinite reasons to be Catholic. Here are only some brief reasons for us Catholics to remember when we are tempted to give in to negativity:*

1. **Religion is good.** Religion is not the distorted, war-mongering mindlessness that secularism may try to make it out to be. It is a re-tying of ourselves to God, a strengthening of relationship with our Heavenly Father, a way of life, a disciplined defense against the devil's tricks. *"The whole concern of doctrine and its teaching must be directed to love...all the works of perfect Christian virtue spring from love, and have no other objective than to arrive at love."* (Catechism of the Council of Trent, preface 10)

2. **Authority.** *Contemporary society does not like authority. Well, no authority above themselves. But, accepting the reality that God is King and loves us is freeing. We also as Catholics can be confident that God, who established this Church through Jesus Christ's apostles, will not let the gates of hell prevail against it—even if people in the Church fall to sin. "I would not believe in the Gospel if the authority of the Catholic Church did not move me to do so."* (St Augustine)

3. **Liturgy.** *The liturgy is beautiful. Stunning. Shockingly similar yet beautifully various in every Catholic parish throughout the world. "A man who fails to love the Mass fails to love Christ."* (St. Josemaria Escriva)

En caso de que no tenga suficientes razones para ser católico, quiero presentarle otra larga lista de razones breves para ser católico que espero sea de su interés. Esto nos llega de catholic-link.org:

*El mundo intentará darte infinitas razones para no ser católico, pero en realidad, hay infinitas razones para ser católico. Aquí hay solo cincuenta breves razones para que los católicos recordemos cuando estamos tentados a ceder ante la negatividad:*

1. **La religión es buena.** La religión no es la insensatez distorsionada y desenfrenada de la guerra que el secularismo puede intentar que sea. Es un reencuentro de nosotros mismos con Dios, un fortalecimiento de la relación con nuestro Padre Celestial, una forma de vida, una defensa disciplinada contra los trucos del diablo. *"Toda la preocupación de la doctrina y su enseñanza debe estar dirigida al amor ... todo las obras de perfecta virtud cristiana nacen del amor y no tienen otro objetivo que llegar al amor"* (Catecismo del Concilio de Trento, prefacio 10).

2. **Autoridad.** *La sociedad contemporánea no le gusta la autoridad. Bueno, no le gusta autoridad por encima de ellos. Pero aceptar la realidad de que Dios es Rey y nos ama es liberador. También como católicos podemos estar seguros de que Dios, quien estableció esta Iglesia a través de los apóstoles de Jesucristo, no permitirá que las puertas del infierno prevalezcan contra ella, incluso si las personas en la Iglesia caen al pecado. "No creería en el Evangelio si la autoridad de la Iglesia Católica no me moviera a hacerlo"* (San Agustín).

3. **Liturgia.** *La liturgia es hermosa. Maravilloso. Sorprendentemente similar pero maravillosamente variado en todas las parroquias católicas del mundo. "Un hombre que no ama la misa no ama a Cristo"* (San Josemaría Escrivá).
