

**PARISH CHURCH of SAINT EDWARD *the* CONFESSOR**

**CODE of BEHAVIOR & CONDUCT  
*for* WEDDINGS**

The Couple's refundable deposit is contingent upon them and their guests abiding by and adhering to this Code of Behavior and Conduct. It is the responsibility of the Couple to ask for the refund within thirty (30) calendar days of the Wedding Day. If the Couple does not contact St. Edward Church within that time, the deposit will be considered a donation to the Church and processed accordingly.

This Code of Behavior and Conduct applies to the entire grounds of St. Edward Church and School, and to all guests of theirs, including professional service providers, relatives, friends, and their guests.

1. St. Edward is a parish church where the Blessed Sacrament — with the Real and Substantial Presence of our Lord Jesus Christ — is reserved. It is not a museum or a rental hall, and all guests' conduct and behavior should reflect the sacredness of the place.
2. Neither eating, drinking, or smoking are allowed inside of or on the grounds of St. Edward Church and School, except in designated areas.
3. It is absolutely forbidden to bring alcoholic beverages or other drugs or both onto the grounds of the Church or in the Church itself.
4. Drunkenness and consumption of intoxicating beverages or substances is strictly prohibited and will not be tolerated. If any member of the Wedding Party, including the Couple, comes to a preparation appointment, rehearsal, or the Wedding in any form of intoxication, the Wedding will be postponed, at the discretion of the Pastor or delegated Clergy.
5. Disorderliness, inappropriate behavior, or lewd and disrespectful conduct will not be tolerated and is grounds for postponement of the Wedding.
6. The Couple will be held responsible for the behavior and conduct of their guests.
7. The Couple and their guests must leave the Church and grounds neat, clean, and free of any damage whatsoever.
8. Inappropriate attire, as outlined in the Preparation & Wedding Guidelines, will not be tolerated. Anyone who appears on the grounds or in the Church in inappropriate attire will be asked to remedy their attire (either cover immodesty or remove hats, sunglasses, etc.) or leave the property. Failure to comply is grounds for postponement of the Wedding.

In the Name of God, I, the undersigned, promise to abide by and adhere to this Code of Behavior and Conduct, and I understand I am responsible for ensuring my guests do so also.
