

**PARISH CHURCH of SAINT EDWARD *the* CONFESSOR**

**PHOTOGRAPHY GUIDELINES**  
*for* **WEDDINGS**

1. Only one (1) still photographer is permitted.
2. This one photographer may only use a hand-held camera.
3. No additional photographic equipment is allowed.
4. No flashes or artificial lighting may be used during the ceremony.
5. Only the one, official photographer is allowed to take pictures.
6. The photographer should arrive no earlier than sixty (60) minutes prior to the ceremony.
7. The photographer may not be in sight of the congregation during the ceremony.
8. The photographer must be stationary during the ceremony.
9. The photographer may not move about at any point during the ceremony, including the procession.
10. The Couple is responsible for informing their Wedding Party, family, and other guests in order to avoid the possibility of embarrassment should it be necessary to enforce these guidelines on the day of the wedding rehearsal or ceremony.
11. Pictures may be taken outside the Church before and after the ceremony.
12. Photographs may not be taken inside the Church prior to the ceremony. No exceptions.
13. Photographs may be taken for twenty (20) minutes after the ceremony on the steps of the sanctuary, provided that proper reverence is observed before the Divine Presence of our Lord Jesus Christ reposed in the Tabernacle.
14. The photographer must introduce himself to the clergy or other representative of St. Edward Church immediately upon his arrival.

**VIDEOGRAPHY GUIDELINES**  
*for* **WEDDINGS**

1. Only one (1) videographer is permitted.
2. The videographer may use a self-contained, battery-operated camera.
3. The camera is to be in one position during the ceremony.
4. The camera may not be located within sight of the congregation during the ceremony.
5. The videographer must be stationary during the ceremony, out of sight of the congregation.
6. The videographer may not move about during the ceremony.
7. The videographer should arrive no earlier than sixty (60) minutes prior to the ceremony.
8. Video sessions are not allowed before the wedding inside the Church.
9. No additional microphones or audio equipment will be permitted on the person of the Clergy.
10. Additional audio equipment is permitted on the ambo, provided that it is not visible to the congregation, does not interfere with the proclamation of the Word of God, and is not attached, affixed, taped, stapled, or otherwise fastened to the Ambo or other liturgical furniture, including the Altar and Tabernacle.
11. Video may be recorded after the ceremony for twenty (20) minutes while the photographer takes his photographs.
12. Video may be recorded outside the Church before and after the ceremony.
