





CHARTER HOUSE UPDATE

The Charter House is in need of volunteers helping to staff the day station and/or generally supervise during the day. As of the beginning of June, meals are being prepared once again at the Charter House. Prior to this time and at the beginning of the pandemic, meals were prepared by the Middlebury College staff. Presently three meals a day are prepared for over 100 guests.

Drop off donations any day of the week between 10 am and 6 pm. Food donations needed: individually (single serving) portioned and wrapped: cookies (if homemade, please prepackage), coffee cakes, muffins, yogurts, fruit cups, pudding cups, raisins, cheese sticks, bananas, canned tuna fish, all hand fruit (esp. oranges, plums, etc.), melons (though they are happy to cut those up there), sliced lunch meats and cheese at least 2# portions (except ham). Pregnancy Resource Center

In previous years, we have participated in a Baby Bottle Drive, starting on Mother's Day, with return on Father's Day. Because of COVID, we did not do that this year; instead, the parish made a donation of \$1200, based on last year's collection. The Center has mailed out letters to those on its mailing list; one can still make a personal donation if so desired.

St. Bernadette-St. Genevieve Parish: New Council Arrangement

This is an opportune time to receive nominations for a new configuration of advisory councils at St. Bernadette-St. Genevieve. First, there will be a St. Bernadette-St. Genevieve Finance Council, in charge of advising the pastor on finance and property management. This Finance Council will be comprised of four members (*ideally two from the Shoreham area, and two from the Bridport area*).

Second, in order to have a more unified pastoral approach, there will be one Parish Council for all: St. Bernadette-St. Genevieve will send two representatives to the St. Mary's Parish Council (*ideally one from the Shoreham area, one from the Bridport area*). Diocesan norms envision that the 'mission' parish sends Parish Council representatives to the 'mother' parish.
