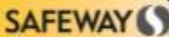

Fat Tuesday Valentines Celebration on February 13th!

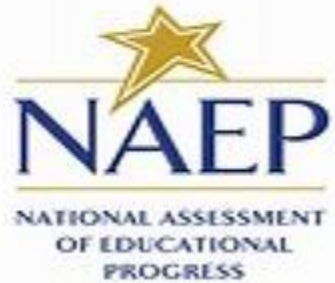


On Tuesday (2/13) students are asked to wear Valentine colored shirts with uniform bottoms! Each classroom will have their own variation on Valentine Celebrations.
