It is with joy that I am happy to announce that beginning the weekend of July 4, Bishop Coyne has reinstated the obligation to attend Sunday mass in the diocese of Burlington. Far from this obligation being imposed, it is part of the discipline of our Catholic faith in which a baptized and confirmed person willingly takes on to practice their faith. Keeping Sunday as the Sabbath day not only honors the third commandment but also is consonant with the practice of the early church where the disciples would gather on the day of resurrection to celebrate the victory of Jesus on the cross over sin and death. The bishop will be issuing a letter to the faithful of the diocese in the next week with further details.

Finally, it is with a deeply grateful heart and sadness that we as a Parish family say goodbye and thank you to Fr. Joseph. With great love and affection, we express our gratitude to him for his faithfulness to Jesus and his prayerful service to the people of God in Vermont. We have all been blessed by his vocation to the priesthood, and especially his deep love for the Eucharist and our Blessed Mother.

God has been so good and present to us through you, Fr. Joseph, and we pray that Jesus will continue to make himself present to His people through your warm smile and kindness, through your inspired preaching and reverent liturgies, and through your example of imitating the Good Shepherd, whom came not to be served, but to serve. We pray, Fr. Joseph, that your priesthood may continue to bear fruit where the heavenly Father's will leads you as it has here among His flock in Vermont. On behalf of our parish, we thank you for being our father, our brother, and our friend. We love and we will miss you...and know that you always have a place in our hearts.

## Diocese brings home nine awards from the Catholic Media Association's 2021 Catholic Press Awards

Vermont Catholic magazine and the Diocese of Burlington's communications team continued their long-time winning streak as together they earned nine awards at the 2021 Virtual Catholic Media Conference June 10. The awards included a prestigious second place in the "Best Diocesan Magazine" category. Vermont Catholic magazine has been recognized as one of the best diocesan magazines in the country and Canada for the last four years.

Alayna Masker, communication manager for the Diocese of Burlington, earned an honorable mention in the Social Media Professional of the Year category, and columnist Kay Winchester earned two accolades.

"When the churches all closed due to the pandemic, communication was especially important to keep the Catholic community connected," said Ellen Kane, executive director of development and communications for the Diocese.
