Hello to all my new parishioners!

My name is Fr. Sahaya Paul, but I go by Fr. Paul. I am a priest from the Diocese of Palayamkottai, in the state of Tamil Nadu, the southeastern corner of India. Born and raised in Singamparai, our Catholic village has an important Shrine dedicated to our patron, St Paul. I began my seminary formation in 2003 and was ordained a priest on May 3, 2015. For my first few years, I served as a parochial vicar in two different parishes in India.

I am the second of 5 boys in my family, but my oldest brother died at birth. My mother made a promise to God that if the next child survived childbirth that she would offer that child to God in service of the Church and His people. That is how I am now a priest. Unfortunately, I lost one of my younger brothers in 2010, but my other two brothers are now married, and I have a nephew, a niece, and another baby is on the way.

While I was on an Ignatian Retreat, I became interested in work as a missionary while talking with a missionary priest who served in Madagascar. After meeting with my Bishop and expressing this desire to be a missionary, I was sent to serve as a priest in the Diocese of Burlington. I had never been outside of India before, and so coming to Vermont was a very new experience for me. I was assigned as parochial vicar to work with Fr. Tim Naples for 8 months at Holy Trinity Parish in Barton and St. Andre Bessette Parish in Troy. Bishop Coyne then appointed me as the Administrator of St. Andre Bessette Parish on June 2, 2019.

A little more about me – I love downhill skiing, swimming, playing soccer, cricket, basketball and fishing. I am also interested in playing guitar and piano, and learning to snowboard and ice skate – even though I’ve never seen snow before coming to the USA. I have a strong devotion to the Holy Eucharist, the Holy Rosary, Our Lady of Perpetual Help and the Divine Mercy Chaplet.

Thank you for welcoming me and I look forward to serving you and growing together in our Catholic faith!
