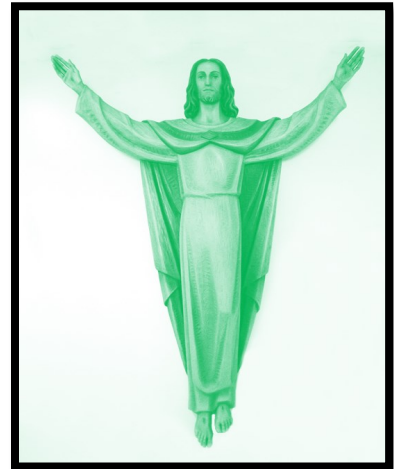
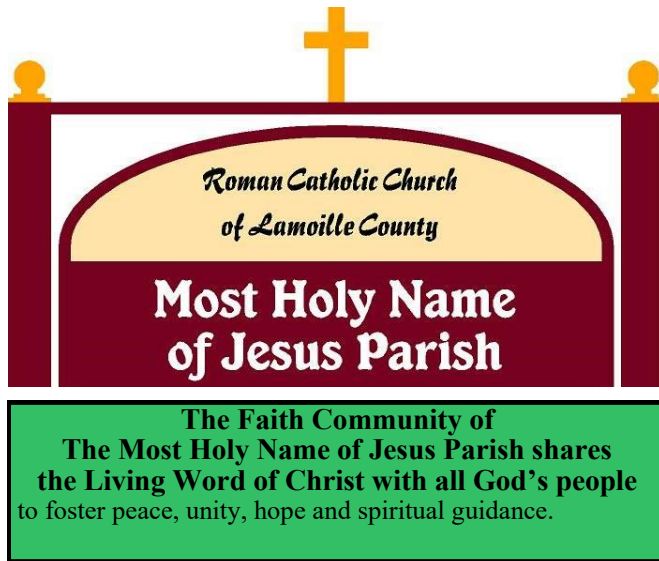

*Dear Parishioners,*



As I wrote about last week, October is known as Respect Life Month for Catholics, where we take action against those specific issues that are against the gift of life. One specific way I would encourage each of you to take action is praying the rosary each day in October for the cause of life. You may be thinking, "Father...is that all? Can't I do more?" There is always more to do, most certainly. However, if whatever we "do" is not first grounded in prayer, it will bear no fruit. As St. Paul writes to the Ephesians, "For our struggle is not with flesh and blood, but with the principalities, with the power, with the rulers of this present darkness, with the evil spirits in the heavens."

To fight against the powers of evil that exist in our world, prayer is our most effective weapon, and particularly the prayer of the holy rosary. The rosary is the recommended prayer for conversion of sinners and hardened hearts, for peace and the protection of families, and is especially invoked in the battle against the evil one and his causes. But why? Why would Mary have such authority over evil? Remember the 5<sup>th</sup> Glorious Mystery: Mary is crowned as Queen of Heaven and Earth.


One exorcist relayed a story from his ministry: *During an exorcism, I asked the demon a question, "Why are you more afraid when I invoke Mary then when I implore God?" The demon responded, "I feel more humiliated being conquered by a simple creature than by God Himself."*

Sr. Lucia, one of the children who received the apparitions of Our Lady of Fatima in 1917 said that God has conferred a power so great on the rosary that there is no evil – personal, family, or social – that cannot be defeated by its recitation with faith. Monday, October 7<sup>th</sup>, is the feast day of Our Lady of the Rosary. Let's together turn to our Blessed Mother with renewed faith in her powerful intercession and pray the rosary throughout this Respect Life month to end all attacks on human life and dignity in our state and that she may conquer this culture of death, once and for all! Immaculate Heart of Mary and our Lady of Holy Rosary...*pray for us.* God bless you and have a great week!
