Dear Parishioners,

Recently I've been reflecting on the reality of hope in the midst of tribulation and distress, appropriately so, as school begins and a 'new routine' is being established. Juggling working from home for parents, going back to school for the first time in 6 months for children, figuring out how to do the 'hybrid' model of sometimes at school, sometimes at home. Travel is not as easy as it once was with state and local restrictions. Where is the constant with so many moving parts in our lives? In the letter to the Hebrews we read, "Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today, and forever" (Heb 13:8).
