*Dear Parishioners,*

In pondering the final aspects of earthly life throughout the month of November from a theological viewpoint, here are some practical steps of preparation to consider.

**Medical Care:** I cannot emphasize how important it is to fill out and register a Catholic Advance Directive that gives clear instruction on your end of life care in a way that is consistent with Catholic Moral Teaching and respect for human dignity and life. You should go over this with your primary care doctor and any relevant family members.

**Funeral/Burial Arrangements:** The funeral liturgy is a 3-part movement of prayer, beginning with the wake, continuing with the funeral Mass, and concluding with the committal at the cemetery. You may consider choosing readings and music in advance, and choosing and/or financing a cemetery lot and headstone. Both a funeral director and Parish Office/Priest could be helpful with this step.

**Last Will and Testament:** During a time of grief, having an updated will can be tremendously helpful for the family. Having clear instructions on what is to be done with the remaining assets and choosing a Power of Attorney to manage them is a great service to loved ones. Consulting a lawyer or an online form would be helpful in this step.

One final consideration I would ask you to pray about is how you might bless our parish after God calls you home. The parish is meant to be a spiritual home, where God nourishes our faith through the sacraments, feeds us socially through friends and other parishioners, and provides opportunities to serve others in the community by living out our Catholic faith. For 30 years, my dad served on the parish finance council in the Church where I was baptized, and I remember how amazed he was when someone left part or all of their estate to the parish so that succeeding generations would be blessed with a sacred, friendly, vibrant parish in which to encounter God and grow in their faith. Thank you for considering how the blessings you've received may become a blessing to future generations of our parishioners!
