Dear Parishioners,

In this week's column, I will begin on a note of gratitude to God for all He has been doing for us. We are still alive despite the challenges we all have been through. Do not give up, God has better plans still waiting for us. Last weekend, I was at the Blessed Sacrament, Stowe, to appeal for some funds, to help some of our parishes in my home diocese in Nigeria, Catholic Archdiocese of Onitsha, Nigeria. I am grateful to all those who have felt the pains of those people in the difficult environments around River Niger. This week I am in Most Holy Name of Jesus Parish Morrisville to ask for the same help.

Last week one of the priests, a classmate of mine who is heading one of the schools in those environments, sent pictures to me. The first thing that came to my mind when I saw those pictures was that there may be violence that led to such disasters, but I was wrong, it was a natural disaster. I placed a call across to know the cause, he told me that there was a storm last week that ripped almost all the buildings of their roofs. Father Joseph Memorial High School Aguleri, is an institution that was returned to the Church after years of being controlled by the government. It was in dilapidated conditions when the Catholic Church got it back. Our Archdiocese put in thousands of dollars to put this school back to shape, so that the children will have decent environment of learning. Last weekend's storm took the school back to a very ugly state, even worse than how the government left it. The good news is that no life was lost. It is a miracle that up to sixteen poles went down in the school, which has led to loss of power, and most of their buildings badly damaged while the students are in session, yet there was no harm.

They will need our help in this challenging time. Our generosity will help this poor community to repair the damage caused by the heavy wind and storm. Remember them in your prayers that is the most important of all. We are witnesses of love. May we be moved by love. You can make your donations to Most Holy Name of Jesus Parish, Morrisville or to Blessed Sacrament Parish, Stowe. The parish will send us a letter to help us in filing for tax next year. At the memo of the check, write "Africa". May God bless you immensely.
