Dear parishioners,
The last few weekends, I noticed quite a few new faces in the congregation at Mass. With vacation season in high gear and living in one of the most beautiful parts of the state, we are blessed to have folks visiting and worshipping with us when they are in our area for some rest and relaxation. One of the hallmarks of a vibrant parish is their sense of welcome and hospitality. As St. Benedict wrote in his monastic rule of life for his monks, "All guests who present themselves are to be welcomed as Christ."

How can we welcome others as Christ? One fundamental, but often neglected areas of parish life is introducing yourself after Mass to someone you don't know or recognize. "Good morning...my name is ____, are you visiting the area?" Research and statistics show the lasting impact that welcoming people that are visiting or "trying out a Church," or even coming back to Mass for the first time in a while. As simple as it sounds, if we know the command to love that Christ calls us to but we don't practice it in our home parish, how authentic will our witness to Jesus actually be? I often try to live by the standard that He taught us, "treat others as you would want to be treated." If you were new to the area, or were trying out our parish as a place to worship, or perhaps coming back to Mass after COVID or being away from the practice of your faith, how would you want to be treated when you found the courage walk into the Church?

We may not consciously be aware of how important our parish is, but the reality is that in a continually changing and more complicated world, our parish family serves as a stabilizing force in our lives. Some of our greatest joys take place in our parish, including the joy of a wedding and the hope that comes in celebrating the baptisms of our children and the reception of their other sacraments. In life's most difficult moments, the church is there to comfort us, particularly as we grieve the loss of loved ones and escort their souls to the Lord with a funeral Mass. Through the highs and lows of life and everything in between, our parish family is an anchor that holds us steady in the mercy and love of God.

Join me in reaching out to welcome any new faces to our parish. We are blessed to have a community of profound faith that will only be made stronger by more families. To all visitors and to those returning to Mass for whatever reason, welcome back and welcome home! Have a great week!
