**Dear parishioners,**

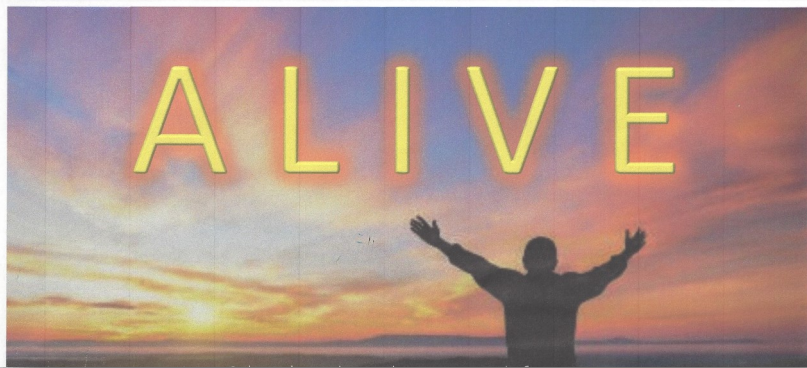
