**Dear parishioners,**  
We have been discussing prayer and discernment, and last week introduced the foundational building block of beginning prayer by considering the love with which God looks upon you, and holding that consideration for about a minute before entering into prayer. Now St. Ignatius mentions moving into the prayer of gratitude. Gratitude moves us to give thanks to God who has been laboring to show His love for us throughout the day. Our God desires to give and bless us, and these consolations and gifts are not something we can earn or merit; they can only be received as a free gift from the heart of a loving father. This first step in prayer towards gratitude reminds us that God is alive and active now, and disposes us to respond to God. We so quickly move through our days and weeks and lives that we miss out on relishing the moments that God is breaking through, that His grace is personally touching our lives, and these moments are what make life so rich, so meaningful, so affirming. A few practical tips regarding this step in prayer. First, when looking back and reviewing one's life, be specific and concrete about the time you are reviewing in order to recognize the specific ways in which God has poured out gifts of love upon you. Don't do an entire life review, but examine the last 12 or 24 or 48 hours in light of the blessings received through the moments, interactions, and experiences of your day. In fact, this step of prayer should not be rushed, but particularly in just beginning, to spend extra time in reviewing in order that you may become more familiar in acknowledging the graces and blessings bestowed on you by God.




