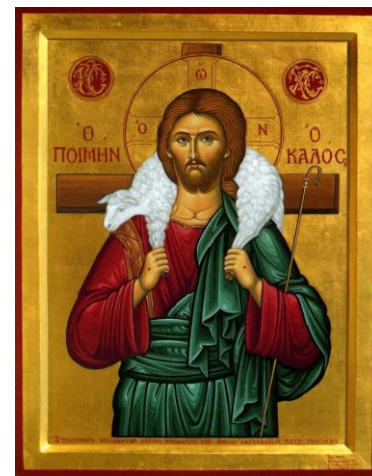

The Ascension of the Lord (Holy Day)

The Ascension of the Lord is commemorated by the Catholic Church as a Solemnity and Holy Day of Obligation. The Ascension of the Lord occurred 40 days after His Resurrection on Easter Sunday. At His Ascension, the Lord Jesus ascended Body and Soul into heaven (Luke 24:50-53; Acts 1:9-11). The Ascension took place in broad daylight on the Mount of Olives, in the presence of His Apostles and disciples.
