**Receiving Communion
in the Time of COVID-19**

Many things about our lives have changed in the time of COVID-19, and one of them is how to receive our Lord in the Eucharist. During this time, the bishop has asked that people maintain the six-foot distancing protocol and continue to wear their mask in the line for communion. He has also asked that people wear their mask when they receive the Eucharist in the palm of their hand and to wait until they step aside (at least six feet from the priest) before removing the mask, consuming the host, and replacing the mask.

Bishop Coyne has restricted the reception of communion to the hand only, following the example of the Diocese of Rome in response to the COVID-19 pandemic. Receiving communion on the hand while wearing a mask should reduce the chance of the virus spreading, which is why Bishop Coyne has asked us to receive communion in this way. He has implemented this and other measures to help prevent the spread of the virus and keep people safe as they worship our Lord. Though many still desire to receive our Lord on the tongue, this is an opportunity to practice humility and obedience, which is very pleasing to God. Obedience is an essential way in which we take up our cross and follow after Christ. Through obedience to the Church and the legitimate mandates of those whom God has appointed to govern her, we are able to grow closer to Christ by echoing his words, "not my will, but Yours be done."
