**Exodus 24:3-8; Psalm 116:12-13, 15-16, 17-18; Hebrews 9:11-15; Mark 14:12-16, 22-26**

*On the first day of the Feast of Unleavened Bread, when they sacrificed the Passover lamb, Jesus' disciples said to him, "Where do you want us to go and prepare for you to eat the Passover?" He sent two of his disciples and said to them, "Go into the city and a man will meet you, carrying a jar of water Follow him. Wherever he enters, say to the master of the house, "The Teacher says, "Where is my guest room where I may eat the Passover with my disciples?"' Then he will show you a large upper room furnished and ready. Make the preparations for us there." The disciples then went off, entered the city, and found it just as he had told them; and they prepared the Passover. While they were eating, he took bread, said the blessing, broke it, gave it to them, and said, "Take it; this is my body." Then he took a cup, gave thanks, and gave it to them, and they all drank from it. He said to them, "This is my blood of the covenant, which will be shed for many. Amen, I say to you, I shall not drink again the fruit of the vine until the day when I drink it new in the kingdom of God." Then, after singing a hymn, they went out to the Mount of Olives.*

### Adoration Chapel

We now have permission from the Diocese to reopen our adoration chapel located in the back right corner of the church with its entrance near Father's garage. Adoration is now back in the chapel on Thursdays and Fridays and we want to add back the other days of adoration that existed before the virus. We are now working on Wednesdays. The chapel hours for Wednesdays will start right after the 8:45 am daily Mass, which usually ends between 9:15 and 9:30 and adoration will end that day at 4pm. The hours that we are trying to fill for every Wednesday are 10-11, 11-12, 1-2 and 2-3. It is a most beautiful space that allows for a special intimate time with Our Lord Jesus there exposed to us in the Blessed Sacrament. Those who have prayed there in the past tell us how beneficial that time has been in their walk with Our Lord. There is a small library there where you can borrow a book to reflect on while you pray, or just sit there and listen to what Jesus may be telling you. There are only two seats in the chapel and we are allowing only one adorer in there at a time, unless you would like to attend with one household member. Because of our new policy, the outside door is locked so unless you have signed up for an hour you will not be able to enter.
