****IN PREPARATION FOR LENT...** Please bring in your old palms & deposit them in the box beneath the painting of the Baptism of Christ. You may do this any time until Sunday, March 3rd. Please do not bring them after that date. Thank you!

****LENTEN DEVOTIONS...** As in years past, there will be a variety of Lenten devotions offered throughout the season. Every Wednesday at 5:15 PM, these devotions will be followed by a meal in our Parish Hall sponsored by the Knights of Columbus & their Ladies. Everyone is welcome and only a free will offering is asked. A complete menu will be published in next month's bulletin.

****LENTEN REGULATIONS...** The time of Lent is to be observed by Catholics as a special season of prayer, penance, and works of charity. Ash Wednesday (March 6th) & Good Friday (April 19th), in particular, are the most important penitential days of the liturgical year. They are days of both fast & abstinence. All Fridays in Lent are days of abstinence.

The rule of fasting states that only one full meal a day can be taken. Two small meals, "sufficient to maintain strength", are allowed, but together they should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals breaks the fast, but drinking liquids does not. The rule of fasting obliges all Catholics from 18-59.

Abstinence refers to the eating of meat. The rule of abstinence binds all Catholics 14 years & older.

The substantial observance of the laws of fast & abstinence is a serious obligation. Those whose work or health would be impaired are excused from fasting & abstaining. The individual conscience can decide if there is a proper cause to excuse. A more serious reason should be present to excuse from Ash Wednesday and Good Friday penance.

Self-imposed fasting on other weekdays of Lent is recommended. Abstinence on all Fridays of the year is also highly recommended.

Parents & teachers should see to it that even those who are not bound by the laws of fast & abstinence because of age are brought up in an atmosphere that is conducive to a sense of penance.

****IT'S TIME TO STOP...** Father John will no longer provide meals to the various groups that rent our Parish facility. If you would like to pick up where he left off, please make your intentions known ASAP.

****IT'S ALWAYS WISE...** With the beginning of a new year, it is always a good idea to schedule the Masses you want to have offered for family & friends, whether living or deceased. It doesn't take long for the calendar to fill in, so don't procrastinate...a word to the wise is sufficient.
