PRESENTATION: Nicholas Black Elk: Oglala of the Lakota Sioux, Servant of God

Cousin of Crazy Horse and subject of the famous book, "Black Elk Speaks," Nicholas Black Elk became a Catholic in 1904. As a catechist he is credited with bringing over 400 people to the Faith. In 2017, the Vatican authorized his cause for canonization.

A lecture on this holy man's life will be held on **Jan. 21st** at **Holy Family Parish** in **Essex, VT**, from **7:00 – 9:00 PM**. The lecturer will be Dr. Damian Costello, vice-postulator of Black Elk's cause for canonization and the author of "Black Elk: Colonialism and Lakota Catholicism." He is a member of St. Augustine Parish in Montpelier.
