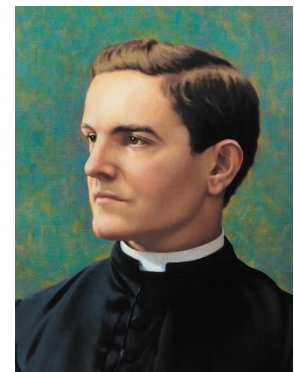
Care Package for Father Gratton
