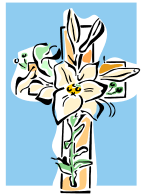

Novena To The Holy Spirit: The novena to the Holy Spirit is the oldest of all novenas since it was made at the direction of Our Lord when, on the day of his Ascension, He sent his apostles back to Jerusalem to await the coming of the Holy Spirit on the First Pentecost. It is still the only novena officially prescribed by the Church. Addressed to the Third Person, of the Blessed Trinity, it is a powerful plea for the light, strength and love so sorely needed by every Christian. For those wishing to pray this novena, copies of the prayers for each day may be found at the church entrances.
