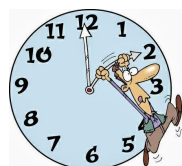

Special Collection:

Next weekend our parishes will take up the Collection for the Archdiocese for the Military Services USA (AMS). The AMS is the only U.S. diocese responsible for providing pastoral care to men and women serving in the U.S. Armed Forces, enrolled at a U.S. Military Academy, being treated as a patient at any of the 153 Veterans Medical Centers, or working for the federal government beyond U.S. borders.
