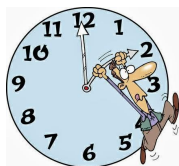

Special Collection:

This weekend our parishes will take up the Collection for the Archdiocese for the Military Services USA (AMS). The AMS is the only U.S. diocese responsible for providing pastoral care to men and women serving in the U.S. Armed Forces, enrolled at a U.S. Military Academy, being treated as a patient at any of the 153 Veterans Medical Centers, or working for the federal government beyond U.S. borders. National Vocation Awareness Week:

From November 3-9, the Catholic Church in the United States celebrates National Vocation Awareness Week. The word `vocationö comes from the Latin word vocare, which means `to call.ö Simply put, `vocationö is a calling from God. The Church teaches that every person is called to become a saint, and in this we have a shared calling from God. A specific path, however, has been marked out for each one of us by God, so that by following it, we may do God's will, grow in holiness, and help lead others into the mystery of the Divine Life. Very often we equate the term `vocationö strictly with `priestö or `nun.ö Vocation, however, encompasses the single life, married life, religious and consecrated life and the priesthood. Although these states in life are varied, holding different expectations and specific responsibilities, every vocation is necessary and plays an important role in the Church meant for the building up of God's Kingdom.
