## From the Pastor's Desk

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

On May 14th Bishop Coyne finalized, and made official, some new priestly assignments. As you know, I had conversed several times with the bishop about where my sacerdotal ministry would best serve the faithful and the churches in Vermont. I will be reassigned as of July 2nd, but Fr. Paul will be staying. Here are selections of the Bishop's letters.

"Reverend and dear Father Naples: By virtue of this letter, I wish to give you official notification that, effective July 2, 2019, you are appointed Pastor of St. John Vianney Parish in South Burlington, Vermont. On this same date, your appointments as Pastor of Most Holy Trinity and St. Andre Bessette Parishes and Trust Administrator of Most Holy Trinity Parish Charitable Trust and St. Andre Bessette Parish Charitable Trust will conclude.... In announcing this pastoral change, I ask that you share with your parishioners that these assignments are made after careful deliberations with the Priests' Personnel Committee and with genuine concern for parochial, diocesan and clergy resources and needs. Your assistance in effecting a positive transition is necessary and truly appreciated."

By a similar letter, Fr. Paul is appointed to assume sole administration of St. Andre Bessette Parish.

"Reverend and dear Father Sahaya Paul: By virtue of this letter, I wish to give you official notification that effective July 2, 2019, you are appointed Administrator of St. Andre Bessette Parish, Troy, Vermont. Your official residence will be at the St. Vincent de Paul Rectory, North Troy, Vermont. However, if at any time it is determined it is no longer possible for you to serve in the Diocese of Burlington, you will return to the Diocese of Palayamkottai. It is my fervent hope and expectation that this assignment will be spiritually beneficial for the faithful of the parishioners of St. Andre Bessette Parishes and for you. As you begin your sacerdotal ministry in the Diocese of Burlington, keep before your eyes the image of the Good Shepherd, Who gave His life totally for our salvation. Strive always to imitate His virtues of fidelity, commitment to the truth, love and compassion... Asking the Lord's blessing in your first assignment and with assurances of my prayers, I remain Sincerely yours in Christ, The Most Reverend Christopher J. Coyne Bishop of Burlington"

Most Holy Trinity Parish will receive Fr. Curtis Miller as its new parish priest in Barton. Fr. Miller was ordained in

2016 and has spent three years as Parochial Vicar of Corpus Christi Parish in St. Johnsbury.

Obviously there will be more information to come in the next month about these transitions. I look forward to communicating with everyone about the work to sustain the Catholic faith in all the laity, parishes, and even in us (clergy), in the Diocese of Burlington.
