Health & Safety Protocols for the Live Auction October 17, 2020

Thanks for your support of the 51st Annual Blessed Sacrament Auction! Our goal this year is to keep everyone safe while still holding a fun event and making money for our school! Keeping this in mind, please adhere to the following guidelines if you are planning to attend the Auction.

1. The Auction will be held outdoors. All guests must wear masks, and maintain 6-foot social distancing guidelines. At 5:30, raffle tickets and bottles of wine will be for sale. Tacos will be available for no charge – thank you Taco Gringo! The Live Auction will start at 6:30 with 25 items up for sale.
2. The Live and Silent Auctions will conclude at 8:00.
3. Silent Auction items may be viewed in the cafeteria by entering the main school entrance. Restrooms may also be accessed from this entrance. Occupancy in the building is limited to 50 people. There will be temperature checks to enter and we ask that you use the provided hand sanitizer at the door. Exit will be through the east side (BASE) door.
4. A hand sanitizing station will be provided near the outdoor tents.
5. Outdoor spaces are limited to 50 persons per space with 30 feet separating each space.
6. There will be periodic reminders from the speakers about masking and continuing to social distance.
7. There will be reserved seating for sponsors only. Sponsor tables and designated seating will be separated by six feet. Other attendees will be asked to bring lawn chairs and maintain 6 feet social distancing.
