We received word from Bishop Wack that Mass has been suspended in the Diocese of Pensacola-Tallahassee until further notice. All Catholics in the Diocese are hereby dispensed from the obligation to attend Sunday Mass while this suspension remains in effect.

We are encouraged by Bishop Wack to "keep holy the Sabbath," by participating in Mass though TV or the internet, by reflecting on the Word of God, reciting the rosary, the Divine Mercy Chaplet and praying the Stations of the Cross. We will continue with Eucharistic Adoration on Fridays, beginning at 8:30 a.m. going through the night until Saturday at 4:30 p.m. The chapel will remain available, by entering the code, for those who wish to pray (the code is available by calling the office). The parish staff will keep office hours but the administrative doors will be locked. We will be answering emails, phone calls, and returning phone messages. We are concerned for everyone's health and safety and our goal is to keep the lines of communications open.

While we are unable to celebrate Mass together Father Steve will distribute communion 'drive through style' in front of the church on Sunday from 11:00 a.m.—12:00 p.m. (noon). Before coming to communion Father is encouraging us to read and reflect on the Word of the Day and/or stream and watch the Mass.

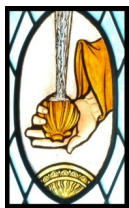
