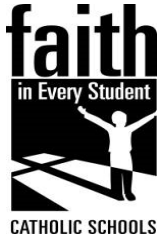

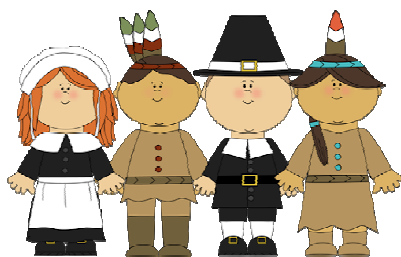

Guidelines for games: Only 2 fans per player; 4 yrs. old and younger may attend also.

Masks are required, social distance.



Symptoms of COVID-19

- Fever (100.4 or higher)/Chills
- Sore throat
- New uncontrolled cough that causes difficulty breathing (for students with chronic allergic/asthmatic cough, a change in their cough from baseline)
- Shortness of breath
- Fatigue
- Muscle/body aches
- New onset of severe headache, especially with a fever
- New loss of taste or smell
- Nausea and vomiting
- Diarrhea
- Congestion or runny nose

Close Contact: An individual is considered a close contact if any of the following is true: Was within 6 feet of a positive person for more than 15 minutes total in a day, had physical contact with the person, had direct contact with respiratory secretion of the person, lives with or stayed overnight for at least one night in a household with the person.

These criteria apply regardless of mask use, face shields, or physical barriers.

If a student, faculty or staff member has symptoms of COVID-19 as described above and tests positive or does **NOT** get tested for COVID-19, then siblings and household members should be considered close contact and advised to quarantine. If the symptomatic person is diagnosed with another condition that explains the symptoms, or tests negative, then no quarantine for close contacts is necessary, but a provider's note with alternate diagnosis will be needed to return to school.

****A symptomatic student, faculty or staff member and anyone living in their household should quarantine while waiting for test results.**
