**\*\*TO STAY CONSISTENT WITH THE FRANKLIN COUNTY COMMUNITY SCHOOL CORPORATION, ST. MICHAEL WILL CLOSE SCHOOL BEGINNING MONDAY MARCH 16, 2020 THROUGH AT LEAST APRIL 10, 2020 WITH A PLAN TO REOPEN, MONDAY APRIL 13, 2020.\*\*** This is a change from the communication sent home earlier this morning. In the best interest of families we felt it would be best to stay consistent with Franklin County Community Schools.

- The week of March 16 through March 20, 2020 will be used as ELearning and students will have school work to complete each day during that time period. PK-2nd grade will have paper packets and 3rd-8th grade will be completing work online.
- The week of March 23 through March 27, 2020 is a scheduled Spring Break, there will be no school work sent home for that week.
- During the weeks of March 30th through April 3rd and April 6th through April 10th a portion of the “20 Wavier Days” declared by the Governor will be used. Students will not have school work to complete during this time period.

The communication between St. Michael School and parents/guardians over this time period will be Jupiter Email, the school website, and the St. Michael School Facebook page.

On Monday, March 16, 2020 between 11:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. parents may come to school through the A1 Main Entrance doors to pick up paper packets, borrow a chromebook, or get any items from your child's classroom that they may have forgotten to bring home on Friday and need to complete their school work.

Preschool families who have already made payments for the days that school will be closed will be credited to future days this school year. Any outstanding amounts will be refunded at the end of the school year.

We are asking our students and families to practice **social distancing**, as recommended by the [World Health Organization](https://www.who.int/). Thank you for all that you do for the students of St. Michael! Please pray for the safety and well being of everyone in our community and around the world.
