 - daily nutrition for your family is a concern. Your Catholic school will work with you to help provide meals.
 - you or your children are having difficulty with the lessons being provided. Teachers can help if you let them know the challenges you are experiencing.
- With public Mass being suspended, many churches will likely feel the impact of lower contributions. This affects multiple ministries, including schools. Please continue your weekly tithing if you are able. And remember, our priests continue to hold daily Mass for the people of southern and central Indiana.

We trust you will continue in this partnership with your school and the archdiocese by continuing your tuition payments. The salaries we are continuing to pay makeup approximately 85% of school budgets. We ask for your continued prayerful support during this unprecedented time. May God continue to bless you, your family, and your parish and school community.
