I wanted to let you all know that the St. Michael School Re-Entry Plan is available to view on the homepage of our website smsbrookville.org or linked here [Re-Entry Plan](#). St. Michael students will return to in-class instruction on the scheduled first day of the school year; August 5, 2020 using the guidelines set forth by the Indiana Department of Education, the Archdiocese of Indianapolis and in consultation with the Franklin County Health Department.

Open House night for August 3, 2020 is cancelled. There may be a digital option for teachers to share information with parents, more information on this will be sent out when it is available.

The handbook with registration information is linked on our website under resources for you to print and fill out, or may be picked up in the school office during summer office hours or in the vestibule of the parish office at any time.
