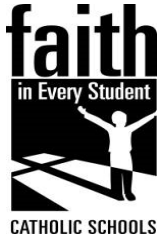

New Security Doors

If you've been by school this week, you may have noticed that the outside doors are different. Thanks to a safety grant through the State of Indiana, we were able to purchase new doors with key fobs. The old doors were showing their age and causing numerous issues: not wanting to stay locked, not closing tightly, etc. Our new doors have a more secure locking mechanism thus making school safer for all. In addition, the key fobs allow us to program the doors to be open at a specific time for any event.

Currently the doors are installed, but the key fobs are still being programmed. Those will be completed in the next week or two. Hopefully the COVID issue will be resolved in the near future and you will be able to stop by school and see the improvements.
