

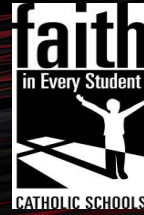

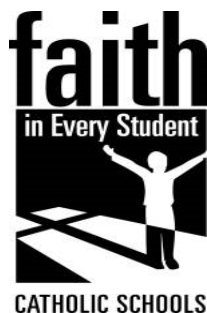

Given what we currently know about COVID-19 and the Omicron variant, the CDC is shortening the recommended time for isolation. People with COVID-19 should isolate for 5 days and if they are asymptomatic or their symptoms are resolving (without fever for 24 hours), follow that by 5 days of wearing a mask when around others to minimize the risk of infecting people they encounter. The change is motivated by science demonstrating that the majority of transmission occurs early in the course of illness, generally in the 1-2 days prior to onset of symptoms and the 2-3 days after.

If you test positive for COVID-19

For everyone, regardless of vaccination status:

- Stay home for 5 days
- If you have no symptoms or your symptoms are resolving after 5 days (and you are fever-free for at least 24 hours), you may return to work/class

Continue to wear a mask around others for 5 additional days.

If you were exposed to someone with COVID-19

If you:

- Have been boosted **-OR-**
- Completed the primary series of Pfizer or Moderna vaccine within the last 6 months **-OR-**
Completed the primary series of J&J vaccine within the last 2 months

You should:

- Wear a mask around others for 10 days.
- Test on day 5, if possible.

If you develop symptoms, get a test and stay home.

If you:

- Completed the primary series of Pfizer or Moderna vaccine over 6 months ago and are not boosted **-OR-**
- Completed the primary series of J&J over 2 months ago and are not boosted **-OR-**
Are unvaccinated

You should:

- Stay home for 5 days. After that, continue to wear a mask around others for 5 additional days.
- Test on day 5, if possible.

If you develop symptoms, get a test and stay home.
