

Note:

- As we reopen the Church, there are a few things that will need to change.
- Entrance is not permitted to those who have an elevated temperature, or are suffering from cough, sputum production, shortness of breath, undue fatigue, loss of appetite, muscle aching, runny nose, chills involving shakes, loss of taste or smell. Those who feel sick are expected to stay home.
- hand sanitizer will be available at the entryways;
- there will be directional tape on the floor to follow; some pews will be taped off to keep social distancing
- there will be no nursery or Sunday school
- Be sure to follow the guidance of the ushers/ministers of hospitality and sit only in the designated places to ensure physical distancing at all times.
- Avoid touching your face or other persons.
- All persons over the age of eight are **strongly encouraged** to wear a mask.
- There will be no hymnals or missals available in the pews – there will also be no singing by parishioners, only by the cantor
- You **do not** need to register for Mass, it will be first come first serve basis
- Collection will not be taken up, there will be a basket at the entry of the church to drop your donation in
- **Communion** must be received only in the hand – you are to form a line but remain 6 feet apart – please stand 6 feet from the minister of communion until after “the body of Christ/Amen” is said, then step forward to receive the Host in the hand then step 6 feet to the side remove your mask and consume the Host and replace your mask
