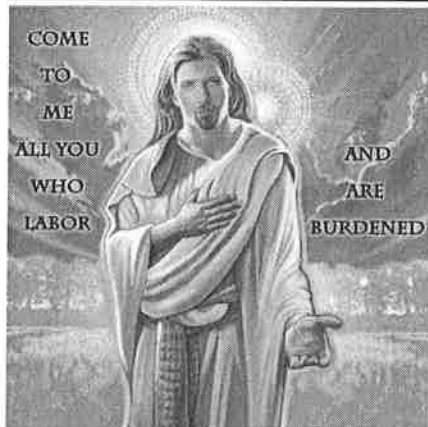
THAMESVILLE FOOD BANK
