<https://southkenticatholicfamilyofparishes.ca/> and click on the 'Watch Sunday Mass' link to view.

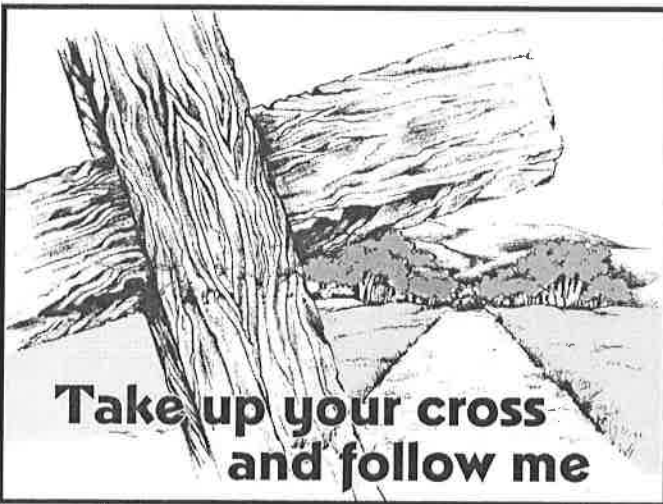
