WHAT'S THE SCOOP

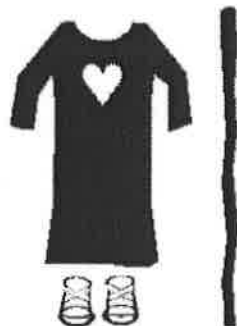

RIDGETOWN K OF C BROASTED CHICKEN DINNER

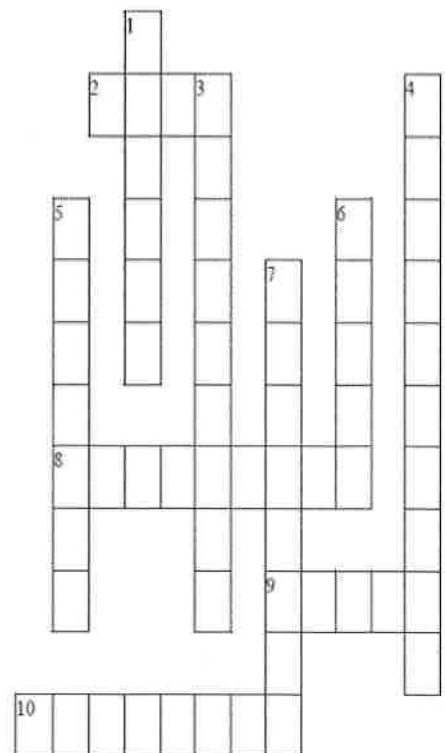
