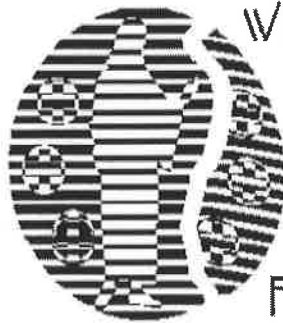

RIDGETOWN K OF C BROASTED CHICKEN DINNER

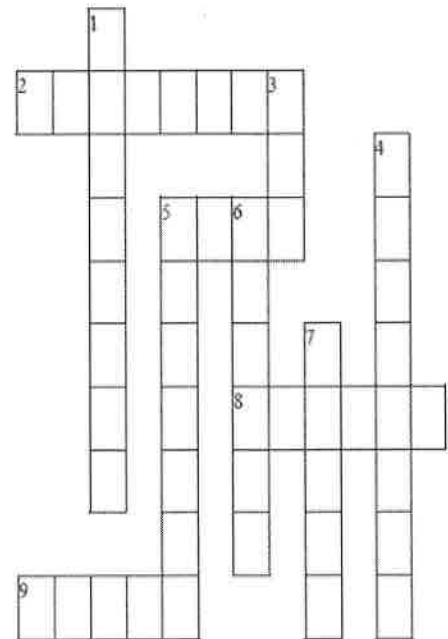
