General Information

Cremation burial / inurnment is becoming ever-more prevalent at Catholic cemeteries. Catholic teaching is clear, however: cremated remains must be treated with the same reverence and respect that is accorded a body in a traditional burial.

This means that the remains of a loved one should either be respectfully interred in the soil or housed in a permanent above-ground structure such as a columbarium.

At St. Michael Cemetery, about half of all committals are cremation. And half of those — thus 25% — are in one of our three columbaria.

Vessels for Cremated Remains

Cremated remains must be contained in an appropriate and respectful closed vessel before their final repose. Frequently this is a decorative urn, although elaborate or expensive containers are not a requirement.

There are size limitations for cremation vessels and depend on which columbarium has been chosen for inurnment. This small brochure does not have sufficient space to list the specific sizes allowed.

In general, if the urn is round in shape, then a vessel 8" in diameter and no greater than 10" high should be acceptable. But given the wide variety of vessel shapes and sizes, it is always best to consult with a cemetery representative to make sure that your vessel choice(s) will fit appropriately.
