- Cremation lots are smaller in size and designed for the burial of one set of cremated remains
- Some families find it to their financial advantage to purchase two or more adjacent graves of this size

Vaults are required by the cemetery for all in-ground full-body and cremation burials

Decisions regarding membership status of an individual, family, etc. may be made by the sales representative in consultation with the parish Business Administrator and/or the Pastor
