PEW CARE & SANITIZING DURING COVID 19

Suggested cleaning requires using a very mild soap and water solution for the wood portion of the pews. Wipe on and off with a soft cloth. Focus cleaning on: Top rail of the back of the pew, End caps, tops, and arm rests, and the front edge of the seat (where people put their hands when they sit down or stand). **From Pat Ratigan...Ratigan Schottler Pew Company.** Using the bleach wipes can eventually hurt the finish on the pews.
