Divine Mercy Parish, 555 W Main Street, Gardner KS will host the veneration of the relics of St. Pio on Tuesday, September 1, 2020. The Rite of Reception of the relics will begin at 7am and veneration will continue until 6pm. **The veneration will be closed between 3pm and 4pm for a private veneration for priests.** There will be a Mass at 6pm in honor of Padre Pio. St. Pio was a very pious priest who offered up tremendous suffering as he endured the "stigmata" of the crucifixion wounds of Our Lord. He bore all pain in humbleness - while in continuous prayer - for the forgiveness of sins (by all humankind). He is the Patron Saint of: Adolescents, Stress-relief and Civil defense volunteers.
