**ARCHBISHOP'S CALL TO SHARE**. What images come to mind when you hear the word "glory?" An American flag flying high as fighter jets streak across the sky? Confetti falling on the winning team as they hoist another trophy? Or perhaps a celebrity all decked out as they accept an award? These are all pretty reasonable representations of glory, on a human level. So when Jesus speaks about glorifying the Father, we might expect him to paint a similar kind of picture: one of power, grandeur, and awe. Instead, the clearest image Christ gives us in today's Gospel is of a grain of wheat falling to the ground and dying. Hm. Not exactly what most of us have in mind when we think "glorious." As you prayerfully discern how to glorify God this week, consider making a donation to the *Archbishop's Call to Share* appeal. Like the single grain of wheat, your generous gift can bear an immense amount of fruit in our parish community, helping us to invite others more deeply into the life of God.
