Importance of Weekend Mass

As a parish we emphasize the impact and importance of faith and spirituality in our or children's lives. We ask that families do their utmost to attend Mass every weekend with the child or children whom they have registered. Mass attendance is a pre-requisite for sacramental preparation because the grace received at Mass is a necessary component of a family's spiritual formation. Saint Peter's Church is thoroughly disinfected after each Mass, seats are marked off for social distancing of at least six feet, hand sanitizer is available at all entrances, and the wearing of masks has been requested of all Catholics attending Mass by Bishop Coyne. As a parish we are committed to observing all current health and safety protocols and providing our families with a safe environment in which to gather for worship. However, due to Covid-19, the obligation to attend Sunday Mass has been suspended by Bishop Coyne, therefore there is no penalty of sin or negative consequences for sacramental preparation for those who are unable to attend Mass due to health or safety concerns at this time.
