

## GENERAL SCHOOL SUPPLIES

All students are encouraged to have a rectangular locker crate for locker organization. The dimension that fits in the locker is 14 x 15 ½ x 11.

General School Supplies for each class: notebook (wide or narrow lined), loose-leaf paper, a 2-pocket folder, pens, pencils.

All students should cover each book that is assigned to them with either a flexible book cover or brown paper.

All **Science** students will need a composition book for lab reports. The book measures 9.75 X 7.5 inches and contains 100 sheets. Watch for school supplies sales this summer. The book is needed for the first week of classes.

**Introduction to Engineering** - Students will need a dedicated composition book, and calculator (the one used for math is fine)

**Foods 1** - Students will need a three-ring binder and loose-leaf paper.

All students enrolled in **Band** need a spiral bound notebook.

All students enrolled in a **math** class are required to have the following:

- 1.5 inch or wider binder
- An adequate supply of loose-leaf paper
- Graph paper
- Dividers
- Graph composition book (for PreCalculus and Algebra 2)
- 12-inch ruler
- Pencils and colored pen(s), not blue or black
- Calculator – for Algebra Essentials, Algebra 1, any Geometry Class
- Graphing calculator – is required for students in classes that have completed a geometry class

All students may use a graphing calculator. Students will be taught how to use a TI graphing calculator in math courses. These include any TI-83 or TI-84 calculator. Watch for back to school sales to get the calculators for as reasonable a price as possible. If you purchase a graphing calculator, please save the proof of purchase barcode and turn it into a math teacher at the beginning of the year. The Math Department is able to get free materials from Texas instruments with these barcodes.

Required supplies for **Spanish 1 & 2**

- 📖 Loose leaf paper for notes
- 📖 One whiteboard markers to be donated to classroom supply
- 📖 One of the following to store all class handouts: pocket folder, a section in an expandable folder, or a 1” 3-ring binder

Additional supplies may be required for semester projects.
