Help needed to take down canopy: The sun shade canopy on the preschool playground should come down for the winter. The canopy was manufactured in Waterloo and is made for Iowa weather, however, the manufacturer suggests it be taken down for the winter so that ice build-up doesn't get knocked down by the wind with the potential for injuries. There is a metal disc inside at the top that spins down (it is probably already as low as it will go) to reduce the tension on the tarp. The edges of the sunshade need to be slipped off the prongs that hold it in place. It is stored in the playground shed during the winter months.
