Preschool Open House: La Salle is hosting a preschool open house on Tuesday, January 14 from 6:00-7:00. Please invite friends and family with children who will be age-eligible for preschool for the 2020-21 school year. Parents of younger children are also welcome to learn more about La Salle as they think ahead to preschool decisions in future years. Four-year-old preschool on Monday through Wednesday is FREE through the statewide voluntary preschool program. A fourth day of programming is available for a nominal tuition amount. Three-year-old preschool is a half-day program that runs from 8:00-11:00 on Friday mornings. Children need to turn three or four by September 15, 2020 to be eligible for their respective programs.

Hockey Game Tickets for Sale: La Salle Night at the Dubuque Fighting Saints hockey game is on Saturday, February 8. Tickets cost \$10 each. We are collecting payments for tickets at the La Salle Catholic School office. Payment for tickets needs to be made by January 31 so we can purchase the tickets.
