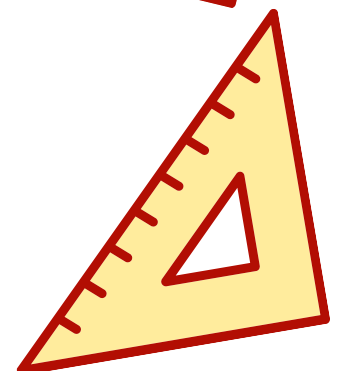
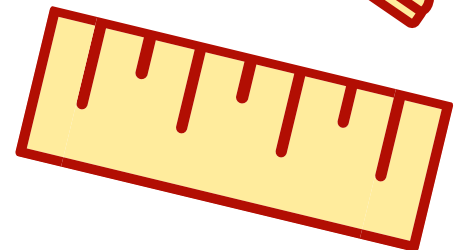
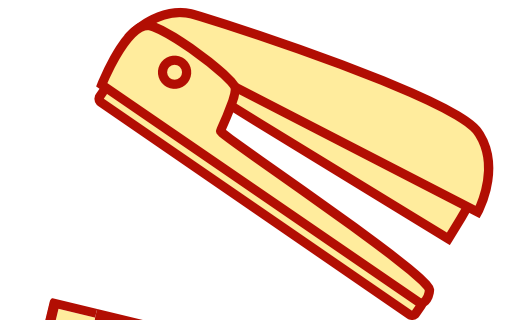
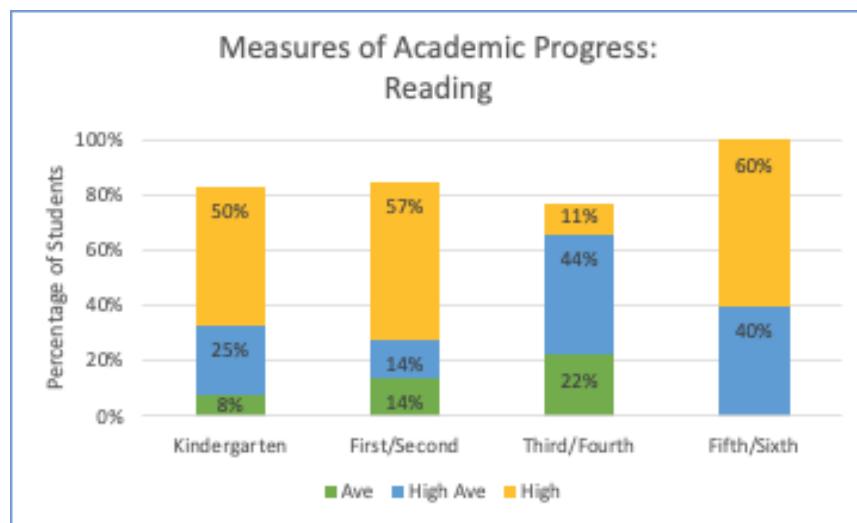
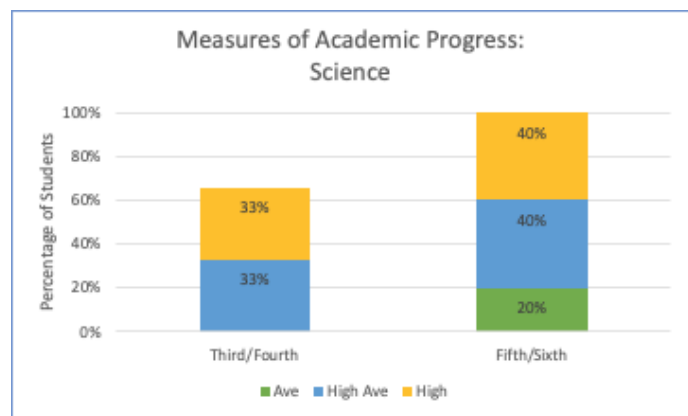
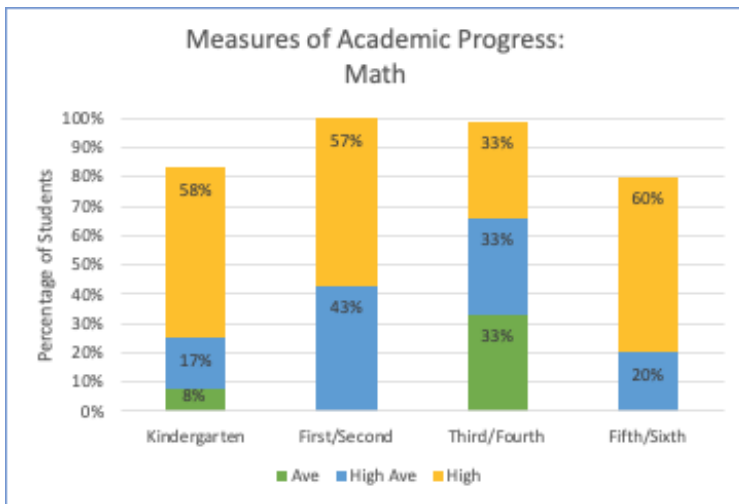
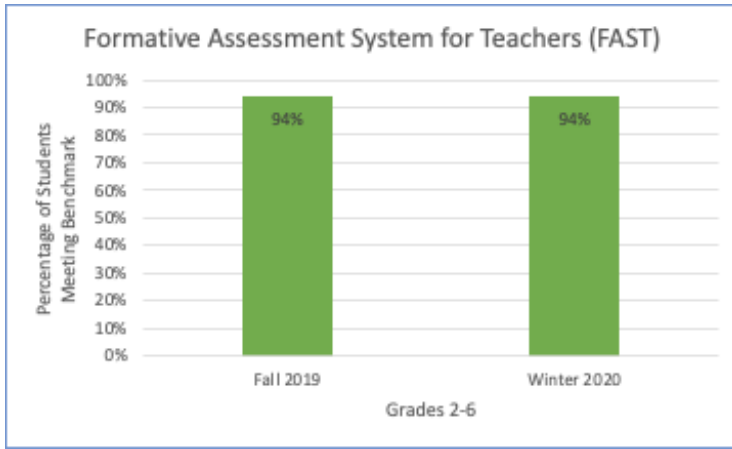


Student Assessment



La Salle Catholic School's goal for our state required comprehensive school improvement plan stated: "By the year 2020, 90% of students in grades 2 through 6 will be at or above the benchmark level on the FAST CBMreading (CBMR)."

The Measures of Academic Progress or MAP tests are norm-referenced assessments La Salle Catholic School students take three times during the school year. Assessment data for this report is from the Winter 2020 test session.



Looking back at the 2019-20 school year, we have much to celebrate in our students' learning and in our strong community. Our school year cannot be defined solely by the shut down that closed all Iowa schools from March 16 through the end of the year. La Salle students and families stepped up for voluntary continuous learning and participated in instruction during the shut down.
